Accommodation:

You will sleep in **4-6 bed dorms** with other participants of the training. Accommodation will be provided from Sunday, 3rd of June 2018 as we start early on Monday!

Food:

You will get breakfast, lunch and dinner at the hostel – they cook every day with fresh ingredients, so we will be provided with good food! If you are vegetarian/vegan or have any other special diet needs, let us know in advance and we organize it with the hostel!

Costs:

The participant fee is 50€. It covers_accommodation, food, entrances, workshop and seminar fees. All public transport costs (bus and train) up to 100€ will be refunded after completing the training. Not included: Additional private spending.

The participant fee needs to be transferred prior to the event. If the full contribution is not possible for you, please get in touch with us and we will agree on an affordable amount!
